In addition, special meetings with officials at the U.S. Embassy and the United Nations will provide diplomatic and global views on the current state of Cuba's political and social landscape.

Havana is one of Latin America's most vibrant cities, and no visit to Cuba would be complete without experiencing its architecture, art, dance, and music. From hearing salsa and rumba musicians on the romantic streets of Habana Vieja to exploring the latest work of emerging artists at their studios and galleries, participants will be immersed in a celebration of Cuban culture.

Each evening, dinners will be arranged at Havana's leading paladares - private restaurants - where participants can enjoy authentic Cuban cuisine and interact with the country's emerging "cuentapropistas". Join us from April 30th to May 5th for this enriching and breath-taking experience.
